From the Barossa to McLaren Vale, South Oz is famous for vino.

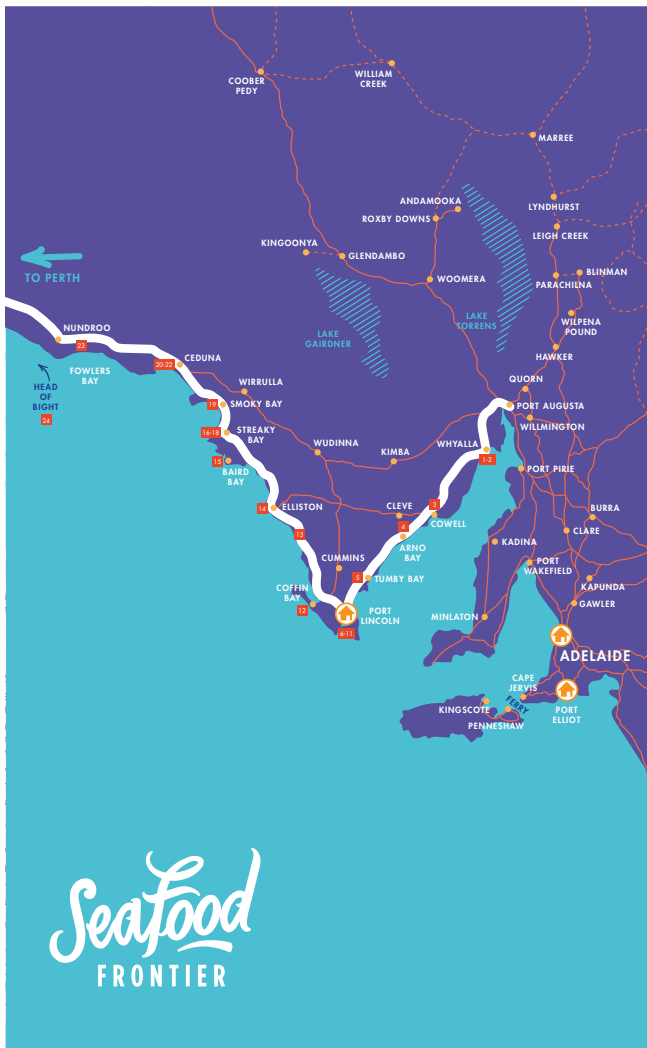
COOBER PEDY
